INTRODUCING PEOPLE TO CHRIST We want to send our students into the world as Bold Witnesses. Every week we challenge them to be about personal evangelism. "O-Night" each month is driven by an evangelistic theme. We want to be missions-minded as well as missions-doing. The Germany trip will not take place as it required a 15-member team, and not enough signed up. However, we are already signed up with World Changers to fly to Chicago, Illinois, and minister to a unique culture there in July 2010. We will also look for local missions opportunities throughout the year.
